



Liphook United Football Club requires parental consent before your child takes part in any football activities.

By confirming the consent at the bottom of this form, you are confirming that you have read and understood the activities being offered to your child, and agree with the measures the club has put in place to manage any risks, including its CoVid-19 measures in line with current Government guidance.

If your child has any specific medical conditions, please ensure that you discuss this with the club welfare officer and/or coach, and agree the best way to support your child's needs e.g you stay to watch nearby and take responsibility to administer the medication. For your information the club may also use a form to gather any relevant information from you. If your child has had CoVid-19, or symptoms for more than 7 days, you must seek medical approval from your family doctor before they can restart any football activity.

If you wish to withdraw consent to your child participating in any or all activities, please notify your child's coach as soon as possible.

Liphook United FC must support NHS test & trace efforts by collecting the name and contact information for participants at both training and matches. This information will be stored for a minimum of 21 days in line with the Government Recreational Team Sport Framework, and collected / processed in accordance with the Data Protection Act 2018 and in line with GDPR principles. It will only be used for the purpose of NHS test & trace.
